Benevolence & Outreach

Throughout the years, Freewill has consistently impacted the community and those in need. This year, we're proud of the many efforts taken to help fulfill our Kingdom Assignment:

- FMBC was able to help families have a Happy Holiday season with our *Toy Drive*. Members modeled the heart of the Father by GIVING, which allowed us to donate toys to Thelma S.
 Morris Elementary, a partner in education and Mary Ellen's Hearth, a women's shelter.
- Our Food Bank ministry continued to bless families giving out over 1,100 food bags.
 Additionally, our Benevolence Ministry was able to provide financial assistance to almost 100 families. Support was also shared with widows and countless sick members.
- FMBC continued to sow financial seeds & contributions to other Ministries, Schools and Non-Profits committed to fulfilling Kingdom calling! We were also blessed to donate 20 pews and pulpit furniture to another local ministry.



Facilities Investment & Improvement

In 2022, we were able to identify and address some areas of need within the buildings and grounds of our campus. A few investments/improvements made are as follows:

- ✓ New HVAC system in the administrative and classroom area. This system replaced two units that were over 25-years old.
- ✓ New additional lighting in the women's restroom located in the lobby of the main sanctuary.
- ✓ The FMBC campus was re-keyed and electronic entry pads were installed to help with improved security and building accessibility.
- ✓ New Window Art was installed at the entrance of the Youth Center. Additionally, there was a complete lobby transformation to make the space more youth friendly.
- ✓ New concreate was poured at the entrance of the main sanctuary to eliminate a tripping hazard caused by settlement and a shift in elevation.
