FREEWILL EXCELLENCE SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The Freewill Missionary Baptist Church Excellence Scholarship will be given to a deserving graduating high school senior who exemplifies qualities of leadership, genuine concern for all people, academic excellence, outstanding character, community involvement and devotion to church. This scholarship is awarded yearly. The recipient will receive a scholarship in the amount of \$1000.00.

Criteria:

--The applicant must have been an active member of Freewill Missionary Baptist Church for at least six months.

--Overall grade point average of 3.0 or greater on a 4.0 scale.

--Two typed letters of recommendation, one from a teacher and one from a church member. You may not submit a letter of recommendation from the members of the scholarship committee, the pastor, youth pastor, or a relative.

--Submit an essay entitled, "Why Should I Be Awarded the Freewill Excellence Scholarship?" The essay should contain information about you, your family, your motivation to go to college, and whether you will be a first-generation college student. Include your accomplishments (academic, personal, community/extracurricular), your educational and career plans (why do you want a college education, what are your future career plans). Describe a personal goal that you would like to reach upon completion of your college education and what personal attributes you will use to achieve it.

--The essay must be typed and doubled spaced using a 10- or 12-point font and consist of 250 to 300 words.

--A copy of the letter of acceptance from the college you plan to attend.

--Interview with Scholarship committee
