- --A personal statement in the form of a 75-100 word essay entitled, "My God Given Purpose and How This Scholarship Works Toward That End." Include your vocation and career plans. Include your accomplishments (personal interests, extracurricular activities, clubs, sports, positions held, employment, and volunteer and community service, etc.). The essay should be typed and doubled spaced using a 12 point font and one inch margins. Please proof your essay thoroughly.
- -- A copy of the letter of acceptance from the institution you plan to attend.
- --Interview with Scholarship committee
